

The Edgerton Fire District Commission Meeting

April 1, 1993

The meeting was called to order by President Jim Linsley, also present was Ken Kirby, Jim Rusch, David Viney, Robert Hellendrung, Clifford Swann, and Dorothy Gunderson. Viney/Kirby motion passed 6/0 to approve the minutes of the March 18, 1993 meeting.

Steve Knudsen has done a walk-thru and is in the process of correcting some of the problems. Kirby/Hellendrung motion to pay the change order, passed 6/0.

Scott Moran was present to discuss the concerns of the ambulance service. Points brought out:

- * the call volume has been declining in this community areas, 262 in 1991, 231 in 1992
- * three other communities they seervice has one ambulance based with a volume of 500 calls each
- * second unit has never been set-up for rescue but mainly for transfers when we had two
- * staffing is a problem for two ambulances
- * the contract states "provide 24 hr. service" nothing about the number of vehicles provided
- * would like to have an agreement to help with outstanding collections. The municipality would pay the bill and then try to collect or put it on the resident's (the person owing the bill) property taxes. Each member was to take it back to their municipality.

A meeting will be in two weeks, April 15th, hopefully Magill will have the loose ends taken care of.

Swann/Hellendrung motion to pay the bills passed 6/0.

Bob Hellendrung reported the Police Chief requested a fire inspection for the City of Edgerton police station.

May 23rd will be the Open House for the Edgerton Fire Protection District Commission's new station.

Kirby/Hellendrung motion passed 6/0 to adjourn.
